


Highlights

- 402,426 lends in 2021 (64% from 2019)
- 5,571 lends to MOBIUS (1.38%) in 2021
- Close to 16 million bib records
- 28 million items
- 63% items held uniquely by one library




Top 10 Borrowers






Top 10 Lenders

Digital Lending

- ProQuest Ebooks Pilot
- SILLVR-Alexander Street Videos and Swank Motion Pictures
- Springer (since 2011)
- Elsevier
- Taylor and Francis



ProQuest Ebook Trial

- Launched Fall 2021
- Current Lenders-Auraria, U of Wyoming, Colorado Mesa University
- 5,500 items
- Only may lend "owned" ebooks and not STL titles
- ProQuest provided a list of lendable titles
- Users receive a title-specific URL with a login to access a title for 2 weeks
- "Proquest e-ill" to pull up all items

SILLVR Update

- Alexander Street Videos (AVON)
- Educational/documentary content
- 5,531 items
- Lenders: Auraria, CU Boulder and U of Wyoming
- Generate token URL passed onto borrowing library



Swank Videos

- 1,280 Feature films
- Limited to academic patrons only; recently expanded to MOBIUS academic
- Lenders: Auraria, CU Boulder, U of Wyoming



Digital Lending Summary

- Low level of use
 - Discovery
 - Different platforms for different content
 - Proof of concept phase
 - Beginning of digital ILL



Library Updates

- No new libraries have joined outside of the SWIFT system
- Center for Research Libraries (CRL) Changed local systems and left Prospector April 2022
- CU Boulder planning to move to FOLIO-later in 2022



Library Updates: API Development

- Colorado College switched from RSB to D2IR
- Ex Libris is currently working on D2IR API. Live in Michigan



Future Outlook

- Continuing to watch progress on Project ReShare as possible replacement for INN-Reach
- Two active groups
 - Infrastructure
 - Resource Sharing
- CO Alliance, State Library and Marmot working together
